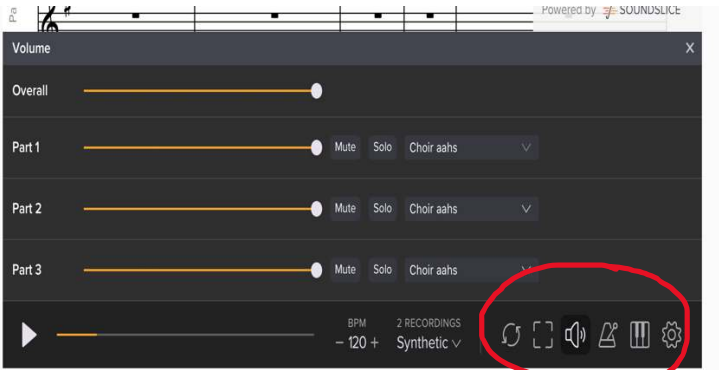


# How To Use Sound Slice

Sound slice is a customizable music education software program where the music notation is synced with a video of the music. You will see a Sound Slice window available for each selection in the Orchestra Sings repertoire:

Function	Activity	How to Do It
<b>Basic</b>	Play and Pause	Click play button or use space bar
	Jump	Click on the note to jump ahead or back in the music
	Loop	Click and drag across a section to repeat. Looping can also be turned on using the circle icon in the black tool bar. To play loop once, choose from the settings menu. To resize the loop, drag handles on either side.
	Change Speed	Slow down or speed up by choosing “+” or “-” or by changing the number in the toolbar.
	Count In	Activate a metronome count in from the settings menu.
<b>Audio</b>	Change Mix	Black Toolbar – Recordings: All parts, Play Along, or Synthetic can be toggled on and off while the music is playing.
	Adjust Instruments	On the synthetic play back, choose the volume button to bring up a separate menu. You can mute or change each part. 
	Metronome	Choose the metronome button in the black tool bar. The settings can be adjusted under the volume button.
	Zoom	Under the settings menu.
	Settings Menu	Transpose, toggle parts on and off, change the appearance of the music.
